If you have a neurological diagnosis, NVSU is your resource to reenter the workforce.

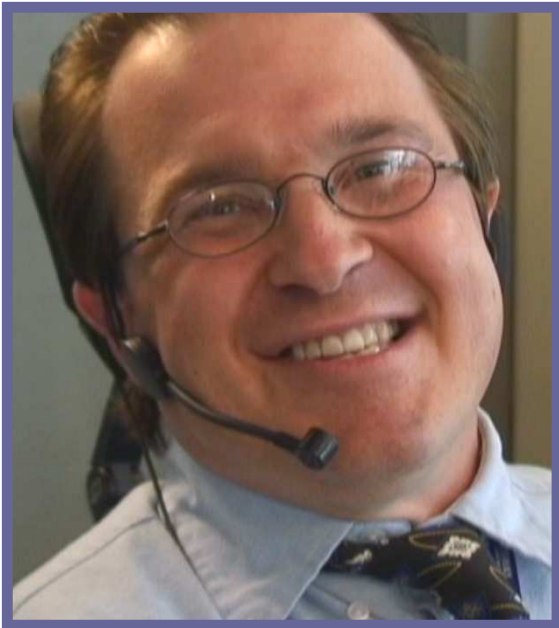

## NVSU History

Neurology Vocational Services Unit (NVSU) has been a long time local leader in matching its clients to the Puget Sound business community's employment needs. Client populations served include individuals with epilepsy, multiple sclerosis, brain injury, stroke or other neurological conditions. NVSU has been remarkably successful in this endeavor.

Since our Inception more than thirty years ago, we have helped more than 2,500 people find and keep meaningful jobs. We have consistently helped job seekers gain employment and provide consultation services to people already in the workforce.



## Service Programs

**Vocational Evaluation** —Assists our clients in setting job goals by utilizing a battery to include vocational interests, work values, personality, and other assessment tools. This provides the client with a structured job goal based on their preferences.

**Community Based Assessments / Job Try Out** — Assists our clients in exploring work opportunities specific to their goals on a short-term unpaid basis.

**Job Club** - Twice weekly meetings for clients seeking employment. Specific topics discussed include organizing your job search, interviewing skills, online applications, and interpersonal skills on the job, among others.

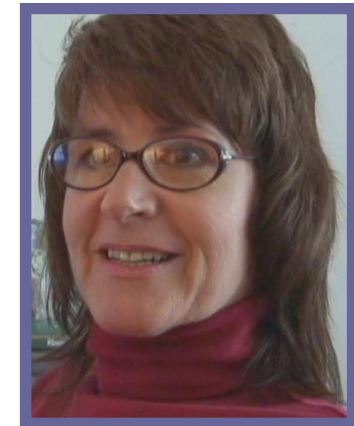
