Hiring qualified workers with a disability benefits your company.



Benefits employers receive by hiring a client of NVSU:

The largest concern with hiring an employee with a neurological condition is that it costs more to employ workers with disabilities. The TRUTH is often times it can save you money:

- Federal tax credit of up to 35% of the first \$6000 paid to client for the first year.
- Labor and industry insurance is covered at no cost to the employer during a tryout period.
- Money is available for on-the-job training or paid co-worker /trainer.
- Other tax incentives (deduction and credits) are often available for accommodations (if needed) within a work setting.

Further benefits NVSU has to offer:

The second largest concern with hiring an employee with a neurological condition is that workers with disabilities lack the skills and experience to complete essential functions of the job. The TRUTH is NVSU has methods of relieving that fear:

- Pre-screened job seekers by qualified rehabilitation counselors/psychologists
- Non-paid job tryouts, 215 hours to ensure the client and the employer are a good match.
- Internship opportunities
- One on one relationship with employer, providing support on any job related issues.
- Follow-up, NVSU provides at no cost to you the employer.
